



## COVID-19 Vaccination Requirements

**Effective November 30, 2021**, all travellers 12 years and 4 months of age and older travelling on any PAL Airlines flight must meet the following requirements:

- All passengers are required to be fully vaccinated prior to travelling;
- Confirmation of vaccination with the last dose having been received at least 14 full days prior to the day you travel, along with a photo ID or two pieces of non-photo government issued ID; **or**
- Paper documents received from a healthcare provider showing proof of full vaccination status along with a photo ID or two pieces of non-photo government issued ID;
- Negative PCR tests will NOT be accepted (except for residents of a Transport Canada approved isolated community);
- Name(s) on reservation must match the government issued ID, as well as the name listed on the proof of vaccination/QR Code;
- Travellers under 12 years and 4 months of age take on the vaccination status of the parent or guardian travelling with them;
- Travellers over the age of 12 years and 4 months must be fully vaccinated in order to travel;
- Proof of a medical or religious exemption with an approved negative PCR test.

It is important that all travellers confirm the name on their government issued photo ID or two pieces of non-photo government issued ID, as well as the name listed on the proof of vaccination/QR code correctly match the name on the reservation.

Travellers who provide false or misleading information may be subject to a fine of up to \$5,000.

**Effective November 30, 2021**, all travellers 12 years and 4 months of age and older travelling on any PAL Airlines flight will be required to produce one of the following:

- Proof of full vaccination;
- Proof of a medical or religious exemption with an approved negative PCR test.
